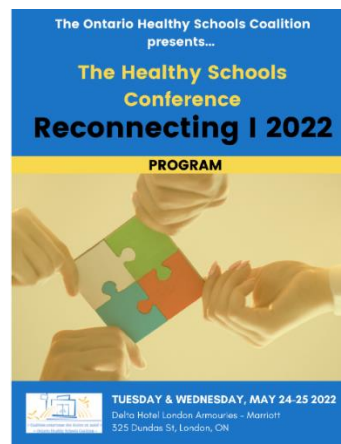

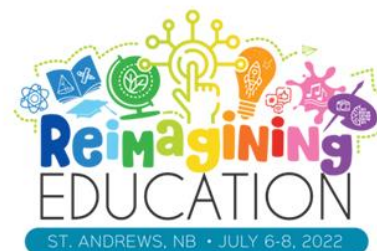
Update on Research

Survey of Ontario Principals Reveals Lack of Action on Challenges

This school year is being called a "*perfect storm of stress*". Findings from [People for Education's Annual Ontario School Survey \(AOSS\)](#) show that there has been little or no respite for educators in the second year of the pandemic. The issues that principals identified in their responses to the 2021 AOSS remain unchanged, and the magnitude and urgency of those issues has only grown.

Healthy Environments for Learning Day (HELD)

HELD is an initiative of the Canadian Partnership for Children's Health and Environment (CPCHE) that is taking place on April 28th, 2022. Each year, this initiative aims to raise awareness of, and encourage action to prevent, environmental health risks to children in early learning environments and schools. This year's focus is on healthy and sustainable child care environments. HELD's 2022 campaign includes the launch of the Healthy and Sustainable Child Care Checklist and Resource Hub in collaboration with the Canadian Child Care Federation (CCCCF), as well as a national survey on environmental health and sustainability in the Canadian child care sector. This year's campaign also includes the creation of a vision statement outlining a broad framework for collective efforts towards a world-class child care system in Canada that supports optimal and equitable child health and wellbeing.
